Leadership Greensboro Now Taking Nominations for Leadership Medal

Greensboro, NC – March 3, 2010 – Leadership Greensboro, a leadership development program of the Greensboro Chamber of Commerce, is now accepting nominations for the Leadership Medal. Medals will normally be awarded to those individuals who are members of Leadership Greensboro; however, those who have made a significant, positive impact on Greensboro and Guilford County may also be selected.

The Leadership Medal is awarded annually and designed to recognize and reward outstanding leadership in Greensboro. Leadership Medals are presented to individuals who demonstrate exemplary leadership, positively affecting the citizens and community of Greensboro and Guilford County. The award is not based on the recipient's views, position, organization or the environment within which the recipient demonstrates outstanding leadership. The intent is to focus on the commitment, courage and positive contribution of the recipient's leadership.

To be considered for this award the nominee must work or live in Greensboro or Guilford County and exhibit exemplary leadership in a community leadership capacity. Leadership Greensboro seeks candidates who are servant leaders, empower others, understand the power of vision, and are change agents. Each recipient will receive a distinguished Leadership Medal presented at the annual dinner for Leadership Greensboro on Tuesday, May 18, 2010. Guests of the recipient are invited to attend.

Nominations will be encouraged from Leadership Greensboro members, chamber members and community at large. A committee comprised of Leadership Greensboro members will select up to five recipients.
